## **1968 CHAPTER 54**

Provisions with respect to performances of plays

#### 4 Amendment of law of defamation.

- (1) For the purposes of the law of libel and slander <sup>F1</sup>... the publication of words in the course of a performance of a play shall, subject to section 7 of this Act, be treated as publication in permanent form.
- (2) The foregoing subsection shall apply for the purposes of section 3 (slander of title, etc.) of the MI Defamation Act 1952 as it applies for the purposes of the law of libel and slander.
- (3) In this section "words" includes pictures, visual images, gestures and other methods of signifying meaning.
- (4) This section shall not apply to Scotland.
