Restrictions on appointment of auditors. (1) None of the following persons shall be appointed as auditor of a society an officer or servant of the society; a person who is a partner of or in the employment of, or who employs, an officer or servant of the society; or (2) A person shall also not be appointed as auditor of an industrial and provident society his appointment as auditor of any other industrial and provident society— (a) (i) which is a subsidiary of that society, or (ii) of which that society is a subsidiary, or (iii) which is a subsidiary of the society of which that society is a subsidiary, is prohibited by virtue of the last preceding subsection; or he is [F3prohibited by section 1214 of the Companies Act 2006 (independence requirement) from acting as statutory auditor of a company which is a

(4) Any appointment made by a society in contravention of any of those provisions shall not be an effective appointment for the purposes of this Act.

subsidiary of that society.]

(5) In this section "company" has the same meaning as in section 15 of this Act and references to an officer or servant shall be construed as not including an auditor.
