PART II

PREVENTION OF PUBLIC DANGER FROM DISUSED TIPS

26 Penalty for obstructing remedial operations and damaging completed works.

- (1) Any person who wilfully prevents or interferes with the carrying out of exploratory tests or remedial operations shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding [^{F1}level 3 on the standard scale].
- (2) Any person who wilfully damages or otherwise interferes with any works completed in the course of remedial operations for the purpose of ensuring the stability of a disused tip shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding [^{F2}level 5 on the standard scale].
