MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Provisions relating to orders made by magistrates' courts in matrimonial proceedings

- Order for maintenance of party to marriage made by magistrates' court to cease to have effect on remarriage of that party.

 - (2) [F2Section 4(2) of the Domestic Proceedings and Magistrates' Courts Act 1978] shall apply in relation to an order consisting of or including a provision such as is mentioned in [F2section 2(1)(a)] of that Act made by [F3the family court] and confirmed in accordance with section 3 of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act 1920 (which enables [F3the family court] to make a maintenance order against a person resident in a part of Her Majesty's dominions outside the United Kingdom but provides that the order shall have no effect unless and until confirmed by a competent court in that part) [F2as it applies in relation to an order made under section 2(1)(a) of the Domestic Proceedings and Magistrates' Courts Act 1978], ...
