#### SAVINGS AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

##### *Provisions relating to other persons*

- 10 (1) The repeal of sections 2 and 3 of the <sup>M1</sup>Exchequer and Audit Departments Act 1950 by this Act shall not affect any pension granted under the said section 2, or any pension, allowance or gratuity granted by virtue of the said section 3, before the commencement of this Act, and accordingly any such pension, allowance or gratuity shall continue to be charged on and issued out of the Consolidated Fund.
- (2) Any election duly made under the said section 2 shall be deemed to have been so made under section 13 of this Act.

- 11 The repeal by this Act of section 665 of the <sup>M2</sup>Merchant Shipping Act 1894 shall not affect any allowance or compensation granted under that section before the commencement of this Act, and any allowance or compensation so granted shall be deemed to have been granted in accordance with arrangements made under section 1A of the <sup>M3</sup>Merchant Shipping (Mercantile Marine Fund) Act 1898, as inserted by section 17 of this Act.
