1972 CHAPTER 30

6 Short title, extent and commencement.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Civil Evidence Act 1972.
- (2) This Act shall not extend to Scotland or Northern Ireland.
- (3) This Act, except sections ^{F1} . . . 4(2) to (5), shall come into force on 1st January 1973, and sections ^{F1} . . . 4(2) to (5) shall come into force on such day as the Lord Chancellor may by order made by statutory instrument appoint; and different days may be so appointed for different purposes or for the same purposes in relation to different courts or proceedings or otherwise in relation to different circumstances.
