Acceptance, resignation and vacation of office, and casual vacancies

86 Declaration by local authority of vacancy in office in certain cases.

[^{F1}(1)] Where a member of a local authority—

- (a) ceases to be qualified to be a member of the authority; or
- (b) becomes disqualified for being a member of the authority otherwise than [^{F2}under [^{F3}section 80A(1)(c) of this Act,] section 79 of the Local Government Act 2000 or section 34 of the Localism Act 2011 or by virtue of], a conviction or a breach of any provision of Part II of the ^{MI}[^{F4}Representation of the People Act 1983][^{F5}, or by virtue of an order under section 30 of the Elections Act 2022]; or
- (c) ceases to be a member of the authority by reason of failure to attend meetings of the authority;

the authority shall, except in any case in which a declaration has been made by the High Court under this Part of this Act, forthwith declare his office to be vacant.

[^{F6}(2) In this section "local authority" includes a joint authority [^{F7}, an economic prosperity board][^{F8}, a combined authority and a combined county authority]^{F9} ...]
