##### *General*

#### 98 Financial provisions.

- (1) . . . . . <sup>F1</sup>There shall be paid out of money provided by Parliament—
- (a) any expenses falling on the Secretary of State or other government department under this Act . . . <sup>F2</sup>,
  - (b) any increase attributable to this Act in the expenses of any Minister of the Crown or government department falling to be paid out of money so provided under any other enactment.
- (2) . . . . . <sup>F3</sup>
