## Power to charge for costs of investigations.

- F2F3 44C (1) The Society may make regulations prescribing charges to be paid to the Society by
  - (2) A "discipline investigation" is an investigation carried out by the Society into
    - possible professional misconduct by a solicitor, or (a)
    - a failure or apprehended failure by a solicitor to comply with any requirement (b) imposed by or by virtue of this Act or any rules made by the Society.

## (3) Regulations under this section may—

- (a) make different provision for different cases or purposes;
- provide for the whole or part of a charge payable under the regulations to be (b) repaid in such circumstances as may be prescribed by the regulations.
- (4) Any charge which a solicitor is required to pay under regulations under this section is recoverable by the Society as a debt due to the Society from the solicitor.
- (5) This section (other than subsection (2)(a)) applies in relation to an employee of a solicitor as it applies in relation to a solicitor.
