



Pensions (Increase) Act 1974

1974 CHAPTER 9

5 Expenses.

There shall be defrayed out of money provided by Parliament—

- (a) any expenditure incurred by a government department by virtue of this Act;
and
- (b) any increase attributable to any provision of this Act in the sums payable under any other Act out of money so provided.
