



# Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975

## 1975 CHAPTER 52

### 8 Alterations and extensions.

- (1) If while a general safety certificate is in operation with respect to a [<sup>F1</sup>sports ground] it is proposed to alter or extend that [<sup>F1</sup>sports ground] or any of its installations, and the alteration or extension is likely to affect the safety of persons at the [<sup>F1</sup>sports ground], the holder of the certificate shall, before the carrying out of the proposals is begun, give notice of the proposals to the local authority.
- (2) Subsection (1) above in particular requires notice when it is proposed to alter the entrances to or exits from a [<sup>F1</sup>sports ground] or any part of it (including any means of escape in case of fire or other emergency) or the means of access to any such entrances or exits.
