Extra-territorial Offences

4 Trial of extra-territorial offences.

- (1) ^{F1}... the [^{F2}Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1973]^{M1} shall have effect subject to the further amendments in Schedule 2 to this Act.
- (2) An extra-territorial offence shall not be tried summarily.

- (4) The further provisions concerning extra-territorial offences which are contained in Schedule 3 to this Act shall have effect.
