HACKNEY CARRIAGES AND PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLES

52 Appeals in respect of drivers' licences.

Any person aggrieved by—

- (1) the refusal of the district council to grant a driver's licence under section 51 of this Act; or
- (2) any conditions attached to the grant of a driver's licence; may appeal to a magistrates' court.
