28 Penalties on summary conviction for offences triable either way.

(1) ^{F1}

(8) Schedule 5 to this Act shall have effect for the purpose of altering the penalties available on summary conviction of certain offences triable either way not listed in [^{F2}Schedule 1 to the Magistrates' Courts Act 1980]; . . . ^{F3}.
