- (a) any institution for the reception and treatment of persons suffering from illness,

and includes clinics, dispensaries, and out-patient departments maintained in connection with any such home or institution, and "hospital accommodation" shall be construed accordingly;

"the Hospital Trust" has the meaning indicated in section 11;

"illness" includes mental disorder within the meaning of [F13 section 328 of the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003] and any injury or disability requiring medical or dental treatment or nursing;

"local authority" means a [F14 council constituted under section 2 of the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994];

"local consultative committee" means a committee recognised by the Secretary of State under section 9(1);

"local health council" has the meaning indicated in section 7; "medical" includes surgical;
