[^{F1}16 Criminal proceedings.

For the purposes of the ^{M1}Criminal Evidence Act 1965 as it applies in relation to proceedings for any offence which is connected with—

- (a) the obtaining or receipt of any benefit under the ^{M2}Family Income Supplements Act 1970, the ^{M3}Industrial Injuries and Diseases (Old Cases) Act 1975, the ^{M4}Child Benefit Act 1975, the principal Act or the Act of 1976; or
- (b) the failure to pay any Class 1 or Class 2 contribution (within the meaning of Part I of the principal Act),

“business” shall include the activities of the Secretary of State.]
