Miscellaneous provisions

132 Proof of documents bearing seal or stamp of [^{F1}Senior Courts] or any office thereof.

Every document purporting to be sealed or stamped with the seal or stamp of the $[^{F1}$ Senior Courts] or of any office of the $[^{F1}$ Senior Courts] shall be received in evidence in all parts of the United Kingdom without further proof.
