"A custodial order under section 71AA Seven years." of the Army Act 1955 or the Air Force Act 1955, or under section 43AA of the Naval Discipline Act 1957, where the maximum period of detention specified in the order is more than six months.

(b) after the second entry relating to such a custodial order—

"A custodial order under section 71AA Three years."] of the said Acts of 1955, or section 43AA of the said Act of 1957, where the maximum period of detention specified in the order is six months or less.
