#### MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

##### *Juries Act 1974 (c. 23)*

- 35 In Schedule 1 to the Juries Act 1974 (persons ineligible for or disqualified from jury service)—
- (a) in Part I, in the entry beginning “governors, chaplains,”, for the words “borstal institution” there shall be substituted the words “youth custody centre”; and
  - (b) in Part II—
    - (i) in sub-paragraph (a) for the words “or for a term of five years or more” there shall be substituted the words “, custody for life or to a term of imprisonment or youth custody of five years or more”; . . . <sup>F1</sup>
