Supplemental

73 Regulations and orders.

- (1)^{F1} any power conferred by this Act on the Secretary of State to make any order or regulations shall be exercisable by statutory instrument.

- (4) Any statutory instrument containing regulations or an order made under any provision of this Act, except an order made under section . . . ^{F4} 76(2) of this Act . . . ^{F5}, shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
- (5) Regulations made under this Act may-
 - (a) make different provision for different cases; and
 - (b) contain such incidental and supplemental provisions as the Secretary of State considers expedient for the purposes of the regulations.
