



# Medical Act 1983

## 1983 CHAPTER 54

### PART I

#### PRELIMINARY

##### *The General Medical Council*

#### **1 The General Medical Council.**

(1) There shall continue to be a body corporate known as the General Medical Council (in this Act referred to as “the General Council”) having the functions assigned to them by this Act.

[<sup>F1</sup>(1A) The main objective of the General Council in exercising their functions is to protect, promote and maintain the health and safety of the public.]

[<sup>F2</sup>(2) The General Council shall be constituted as provided for by order of the Privy Council, subject to Part 1 of Schedule 1 to this Act.]

[<sup>F3</sup>(3) The General Council shall have the following committees—

<sup>F4</sup>(a) .....

(b) one or more Interim Orders Panels,

(c) one or more [<sup>F5</sup>Registration Panels],

(d) one or more Registration Appeals Panels,

(e) the Investigation Committee,

(f) one or more Fitness to Practise Panels,

constituted in accordance with Part III of Schedule 1 to this Act and having the functions assigned to them by or under this Act.

(3A) The committees of the General Council specified in [<sup>F6</sup>paragraphs (c), (d) and (e)] of subsection (3) above are referred to in this Act as “the statutory committees”.]

(4) Schedule 1 to this Act shall have effect with respect to the General Council, its branch councils and committees, its proceedings, its officers and its accounts.

## 2 Registration of medical practitioners.

- (1) There shall continue to be kept by the registrar of the General Council (in this Act referred to as “the Registrar”) [<sup>F7</sup>a register] of medical practitioners registered under this Act containing the names of those registered and the qualifications they are entitled to have registered under this Act.
- (2) The [<sup>F8</sup>register referred to is] “the register of medical practitioners” consisting of [<sup>F9</sup>the following lists]—
- (a) the principal list,
  - [<sup>F10</sup>(aa) if anyone is registered under section 18A, the emergency powers doctors list,]
  - [<sup>F11</sup>(b) .....
  - (c) the visiting overseas doctors list, and
  - [<sup>F12</sup>(d) the list of visiting medical practitioners from relevant European States]
  - [<sup>F13</sup>.....]
- (3) Medical practitioners shall be registered as fully registered medical practitioners or provisionally <sup>F14</sup>... as provided in Parts II and III of this Act and in the appropriate list of the register of medical practitioners <sup>F15</sup>... as provided in Part IV of this Act.
- [<sup>F16</sup>(4) Section 35C(2)(da) (the necessary knowledge of English) shall not apply in determining whether a person’s fitness to practise is impaired for the purposes of registration under this Act.]
