SCHEDULE 1

TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS AND SAVINGS

Amendment and repeal of Acts etc.

- 5 Any power that is exercisable by virtue of—
- (a) section 317 of the Public Health Act 1936,
 - (b) section 82 of the ^{M1} Public Health Act 1961,
 - (c) section 84 of the ^{M2} London Government Act 1963, or
 - (d) section 48 of the ^{M3} Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982,
- in relation to a provision of one of those Acts that is repealed and re-enacted by this Act shall be exercisable in relation to that provision as so re-enacted to the extent to which it would have been exercisable immediately before such repeal.
