SCHEDULE 4

CONTROL OF OFF-STREET PARKING

PART I

PROVISIONS AS TO THE MAKING OF REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 43

3 In the case of any proposal, the Secretary of State may at any time before the expiration of the period of twelve weeks give to [^{F1}the local authority] a direction in writing that, except with the consent of the Secretary of State, regulations shall not be made in pursuance of that proposal—

- (a) with respect to all, or with respect to such as may be specified, of the matters to which the proposal relates; or
- (b) in relation to, or to a specified part of, any specified area which has been or is proposed to be designated as a controlled area;

and on any such direction being given the Secretary of State shall cause notice thereof to be published in the London Gazette and [^{F1}the local authority] shall comply with that direction.
