CONTROL OF OFF-STREET PARKING

PART I

PROVISIONS AS TO THE MAKING OF REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 43

In the case of any proposal, the Secretary of State may at any time before the expiration of the period of twelve weeks give to [^{F1}the local authority] a direction in writing that, except with the consent of the Secretary of State, regulations shall not be made in pursuance of that proposal—

- (a) with respect to all, or with respect to such as may be specified, of the matters to which the proposal relates; or
- (b) in relation to, or to a specified part of, any specified area which has been or is proposed to be designated as a controlled area;

and on any such direction being given the Secretary of State shall cause notice thereof to be published in the London Gazette and [F1 the local authority] shall comply with that direction.
