#### *Interpretation*

<sup>F1</sup>5 In this Schedule—

- (a) “adoption agency” [<sup>F2</sup>, “adoption order”, “placed for adoption by an adoption agency” and “placement order” have the same meaning as in the Adoption and Children Act 2002; and]
- (b) “area”, in relation to a magistrates’ court, means the petty sessions area <sup>F3</sup> . . . for which the court is appointed.]
