# **1984 CHAPTER 55**

#### PART II

SUPERVISION OF BUILDING WORK ETC. OTHERWISE THAN BY [FILOCAL AUTHORITIES] [FIBUILDING CONTROL AUTHORITIES]

Supervision of plans and work by approved inspectors

# 48 Effect of initial notice.

- (1) So long as an initial notice continues in force, the function of enforcing building regulations that is conferred on a local authority by section 91(2) below is not exercisable in relation to the work [F1 to which the notice relates], and accordingly—
  - (a) a local authority may not give a notice under section [F235B, 35C or] 36(1) above in relation to [F3that work], and
  - (b) a local authority may not institute proceedings under section 35 above for a contravention [F4 of building regulations] that arises out of the carrying out of [F3 that work].
- (2) For the purposes of the enactments specified in subsection (3) below—
  - (a) the giving of an initial notice accompanied by such plans as are referred to in section 47(1)(b) above shall be treated as the [F5 deposit of plans][F5 making of an application for building control approval],
  - (b) the plans accompanying an initial notice shall be treated as the [<sup>F6</sup>deposited plans][<sup>F6</sup>plans accompanying the application for building control approval],
  - (c) the acceptance or rejection of an initial notice shall be treated as the [F7 passing or, as the case may be, the rejection of plans] [F7 approval or rejection of the application], and
  - (d) [F8where an initial notice ceases to be in force under section 53A, the application for building control approval (treated by virtue of paragraph (a) as made) is to be treated as if it was not made (and the approval was not given).]
