



Co-operative Development Agency and Industrial Development Act 1984

1984 CHAPTER 57

An Act to amend the Co-operative Development Agency Act 1978 and confer power on the Secretary of State to dissolve the Agency; to amend the power in section 1 of the Industrial Development Act 1982 to designate assisted areas and to replace the provisions of Part II of that Act for the making of regional development grants. [31st October 1984]
