



Elections (Northern Ireland) Act 1985

1985 CHAPTER 2

An Act to make further provision for preventing personation at elections in Northern Ireland. [24th January 1985.]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
