#### POLICE, FIRE SERVICES, CIVIL DEFENCE AND TRANSPORT

##### *Members of joint authorities*

### **31 Replacement of members.**

- (1) A constituent council may at any time terminate the appointment of a person appointed by it to a joint authority and appoint another member of the council in his place.
- (2) Where a constituent council exercises its powers under this section—
  - (a) it shall give notice of the new appointment and of the termination of the previous appointment to the authority to which those appointments were made; and
  - (b) subject to <sup>[F1]</sup>subsection (3) below and to] section 32(5) below, the new appointment shall take effect, and the previous appointment shall terminate, at the end of one month from the date on which the notice is given.
- <sup>[F2]</sup>(3) Where a constituent council exercises its powers under this section to replace a person who has continued to be a member of a joint authority by virtue of section 32(1A) below and notice is given not later than seven days after the council's annual meeting next following his retirement and re-election, his appointment shall terminate and the new appointment shall take effect upon the notice being given.]
