PART I

OCCUPATIONAL PENSIONS

1 Short service benefit for members of schemes whose employment is terminated before age of 26.

Paragraph 6(1)(a) of Schedule 16 to the ^{M1}Social Security Act 1973 (the effect of which is that an occupational pension scheme need not provide benefit for a member whose service in relevant employment is terminated before he has attained the age of 26) shall cease to have effect.
