CUSTODY ORDERS

PART II

SCOTLAND

- An order made by a court of civil jurisdiction in Scotland under any enactment or rule of law with respect to the custody, care or control of a child or access to a child, excluding—
 - (i) an order placing a child under the supervision of a local authority;
 - (ii) an adoption order under section 12(1) of the Adoption (Scotland) Act 1978;
 - (iii) an order relating to the tutory or curatory of a child;
 - (iv) an order made under section 16(8), 16A(3) or 18(3) of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968;
 - (v) an order made in the exercise of any power under Part III of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 to authorise any person to take a child to a place of safety, to issue, renew or recall a warrant for the apprehension or detention of a child, or to order the detention of a child in secure accommodation;
 - (vi) an order made in proceedings under this Act.
- A supervision requirement or other order made by a children's hearing in Scotland under section 44(1), 47, 48, 72(1) or 74(1) of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968.
- An order made by the Secretary of State under section 74(3) of the said Act of 1968.
