Miscellaneous and supplementary

96 Transitional provisions and savings.

- (1) Schedule 11 to this Act (which contains transitional provisions and savings) shall have effect.
- (2) The re-enactment—
 - (a) in section 84(3) of, and Part IV of Schedule 5 to, this Act, of provisions contained in the ^{M1}Weights and Measures (Solid Fuel) (Carriage by Rail) Order 1966, and
 - (b) in paragraphs 12 to 17, 22 and 25 of Schedule 11 to this Act, of provisions contained in the ^{M2}Units of Measurement Regulations 1978 and the ^{M3}Units of Measurement Regulations 1980,shall be without prejudice to the validity of those provisions; and any question as to the validity of any of those provisions shall be determined as if the re-enacting provision of this Act were contained in a statutory instrument made under the powers under which the original provision was made.
- (3) The provisions of Schedule 11 to this Act are without prejudice to the operation of sections 16 and 17 of the ^{M4}Interpretation Act 1978 (which relate to the effect of repeals).
