Regulation of insider dealing

- Prohibition on stock exchange deals by insiders, etc.
- Abuse of information obtained in official capacity.
- Actions not prohibited by ss. 1, 2.
- Off-market deals in advertised securities.
- Restriction on promoting off-market deals abroad.
- Price stabilisation.
- Trustees and personal representatives.
- Punishment of contraventions.
