LOCAL AUTHORITY PUBLICITY

[^{F1}2A Prohibition on promoting homosexuality by teaching or by publishing material.

- (1) A local authority shall not-
 - (a) intentionally promote homosexuality or publish material with the intention of promoting homosexuality;
 - (b) promote the teaching in any maintained school of the acceptability of homosexuality as a pretended family relationship.
- (2) Nothing in subsection (1) above shall be taken to prohibit the doing of anything for the purpose of treating or preventing the spread of disease.
- (3) In any proceedings in connection with the application of this section a court shall draw such inferences as to the intention of the local authority as may reasonably be drawn from the evidence before it.
- (4) In subsection (1)(b) above "maintained school" means,—
 - (a) in England and Wales, a county school, voluntary school, nursery school or special school, within the meaning of [^{F2}the Education Act 1996]]; and
 - (b) in Scotland, a public school, nursery school or special school, within the meaning of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980.
