#### COMPENSATION TO TENANT FOR IMPROVEMENTS BEGUN BEFORE 1ST MARCH 1948

##### PART II

###### OLD IMPROVEMENTS FOR WHICH COMPENSATION IS PAYABLE

- 1 Erection, alteration or enlargement of buildings.
- 2 Formation of silos.
- 3 Making and planting of osier beds.
- 4 Making of water meadows or works of irrigation.
- 5 Making of gardens.
- 6 Making or improvement of roads or bridges.
- 7 Making or improvement of watercourses, ponds, wells or reservoirs or of works for the application of water power or for supply of water for agricultural or domestic purposes.
- 8 Making or removal of permanent fences.
- 9 Planting of hops.
- 10 Planting of orchards or fruit bushes.
- 11 Reclaiming of waste land.
- 12 Warping or weiring of land.
- 13 Embankments and sluices against floods.
- 14 Erection of wirework in hop gardens.
- 15 Provision of permanent sheep-dipping accommodation.
- 16 Drainage.
