



Control of Pollution (Amendment) Act 1989

1989 CHAPTER 14

8 Regulations.

(1) The powers of the Secretary of State under this Act to make regulations^[F1] or orders] shall be exercisable by statutory instrument subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.

[^{F2}(1A) The powers of the National Assembly for Wales to make regulations or orders under sections 5 to 5C above are exercisable by statutory instrument.]

(2) Regulations^[F3] or orders] made in exercise of any such power may—

- (a) contain such supplemental, consequential and transitional provision as the considers appropriate; and
- (b) make different provision for different cases (including different provision for different persons, circumstances or localities).
