  (1) Every local authority shall make arrangements for the provision of assistance to—

- (3) The arrangements
  - shall secure that a person may not provide assistance if he is a person who is prevented from doing so by regulations made by the [F4Secretary of State]; and
  - shall comply with any other provision made by the regulations in relation to (b) the arrangements.
- (4) The [F5Secretary of State] may make regulations requiring local authorities to monitor the steps that they have taken with a view to ensuring that they comply with regulations made for the purposes of subsection (3).
- (5) Every local authority shall give such publicity to their arrangements for the provision of assistance under this section as they consider appropriate.]]
