SCHEDULE 3

TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS AND SAVINGS

Delegation

- 4 Section 19 of this Act (in this paragraph referred to as the “relevant section”) shall—
- (a) until the first transfer date, have effect in relation to the Scottish Development Agency as the relevant section has effect (or as the case may be is to have effect) in relation to Scottish Enterprise, except that the reference in paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of the relevant section to section 8(11) of this Act shall be construed as a reference to section 9(3) of the Scottish Development Agency Act 1975 (attraction of provisions relating to acquisition of land) and that paragraph (a) of the said subsection (2) shall be disregarded; and
 - (b) until the second transfer date, have effect in relation to the Highlands and Islands Development Board as the relevant section has effect (or as the case may be is to have effect) in relation to Highlands and Islands Enterprise, except that any reference in subsection (1) of the relevant section to functions shall be construed as a reference to duties under paragraph (c) of section 3(1) of the ^{M1}Highlands and Islands Development (Scotland) Act 1965 (measures to implement certain proposals) and that paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (2) of the relevant section shall be disregarded.
