PROBATE

Advice from the Advisory Committee

- 1 (1) Where the [^{F1}Secretary of State] receives an application from a professional or other body ("the applicant") for approval under this Schedule, he shall refer the application to the [^{F2}Consultative Panel].
- (2) It shall be the duty of the [^{F2}Consultative Panel] to consider the application and to give to the [^{F1}Secretary of State] such advice as it considers appropriate.
