ADDITIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED ON TELEVISION BROADCASTING FREQUENCIES

54 Additional services not to interfere with other transmissions.

- (1) An additional services licence may include such conditions as [^{F1}OFCOM] consider appropriate for securing that the provision of any additional service under the licence does not cause any interference with—
- (a) the television broadcasting service or services on whose frequency or frequencies it is provided, or
 - (b) any other wireless telegraphy transmissions.
