- For section 176(1) and (2) there is substituted—
 - "(1) On an appeal under section 174 the Secretary of State may—
 - (a) correct any defect, error or misdescription in the enforcement notice; or
 - (b) vary the terms of the enforcement notice, if he is satisfied that the correction or variation will not cause injustice to the appellant or the local planning authority.
 - (2) Where the Secretary of State determines to allow the appeal, he may quash the notice.
 - (2A) The Secretary of State shall give any directions necessary to give effect to his determination on the appeal."
