LOCAL GOVERNMENT CHANGES FOR ENGLAND

Supplemental provisions of Part II

27 Amendments relating to local government changes.

- (1) Schedule 3 to this Act (which contains consequential amendments in connection with the provisions of this Part) shall have effect.
- (2) In considering the electoral arrangements for any local government area for the purposes of this Part [^{F1}the Electoral Commission and the Boundary Committee for England] shall comply, so far as is reasonably practicable, with the rules set out in Schedule 11 to the 1972 Act (rules to be observed in considering electoral arrangements); and accordingly, in that Schedule, references to “either of the Commissions” shall have effect—
 - (a) until the commencement of section 24 above, as including a reference to the Local Government Commission; and
 - (b) thereafter, as if they were references to the [^{F1}the Electoral Commission and the Boundary Committee for England] or the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales.
- (3) In subsection (2) above “electoral arrangements” has the meaning given by subsection (4) of section 14 above for the purposes of subsection (1)(c) of that section.
