



Still-Birth (Definition) Act 1992

1992 CHAPTER 29

1 Meaning of “still-born child”, etc.

- (1) In section 12 of the ^{M1}Births and Deaths Registration Act 1926 (definitions) and section 41 of the ^{M2}Births and Deaths Registration Act 1953 (interpretation), in the provisions which relate to the meaning of “still-born child” for the words “twenty-eighth week”, in both places where they occur, there shall be substituted “twenty-fourth week”.
- (2) In section 56(1) of the ^{M3}Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Scotland) Act 1965 (interpretation) in the definition of “still-born child” for the words “twenty-eighth week” there shall be substituted “twenty-fourth week”.
