#### GENERAL AND SUPPLEMENTARY

### Supplementary

#### 121 Orders and regulations.

- (1) Any power of the Treasury <sup>F1</sup>. . . to make regulations or an order under this Act is exercisable by statutory instrument.
- (2) Any statutory instrument containing such regulations or such an order, other than an order under [F2 section 5] above or section 126 below, shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
- (3) Any power conferred by this Act to make such regulations or such an order includes power—
  - (a) to make different provision for different cases; and
  - (b) to make transitional, consequential or supplementary provision.
