PART I

ORDERS AUTHORISING WORKS ETC

Power to make orders

1 Orders as to railways, tramways etc.

- (1) The Secretary of State may make an order relating to, or to matters ancillary to, the construction or operation of a transport system of any of the following kinds, so far as it is in England and Wales—
- a railway;
 - a tramway;
 - a trolley vehicle system;
 - a system using a mode of guided transport prescribed by order made under section 2 below.

[^{F1}(1A) Subsection (1) is subject to—

- section 33(2) of the Planning Act 2008 (exclusion of powers to authorise development);
- section 120(9) of that Act (exclusion of power to include ancillary provision in orders).]

- (2) The power to make orders under this section shall be exercisable by statutory instrument.
