

Protection of Badgers Act 1992

1992 CHAPTER 51

Enforcement and penalties

[F112A Time limit for bringing summary proceedings

- (1) Summary proceedings for an offence under [F2 a provision mentioned in subsection (1A)] may, subject to subsection (2) below, be brought within a period of 6 months from the date on which evidence sufficient in the opinion of the prosecutor to warrant the proceedings came to the prosecutor's knowledge.
 - The provisions referred to in subsection (1) are—
- (1A) (a) section 1(3), (5) and (6) (in relation to an act made unlawful by section 1(3)),
 - (b) section 2(1)(d) and (3) (in relation to an act made unlawful by section 2(1)(d)),
 - (c) section 3,
 - (d) section 4,
 - (e) section 5,
 - (f) section 10(8).]
 - (2) No such proceedings may be brought more than 3 years—
 - (a) after the commission of the offence, or
 - (b) in the case of a continuous contravention, after the last date on which the offence was committed.
 - (3) A certificate signed by or on behalf of the prosecutor and stating the date on which such evidence came to the prosecutor's knowledge is conclusive evidence of that fact; and a certificate stating that matter and purporting to be so signed is to be treated as being so signed unless the contrary is proved.]
