Supplementary

11 Interpretation and consequential amendments.

(1) In this Act—

- (a) “the 1989 Act ” means the ^{M1}Security Service Act 1989;
- (b) “the Commissioner ” means the Commissioner appointed under section 8 above;
- (c) “Minister of the Crown ” has the same meaning as in the ^{M2}Ministers of the Crown Act 1975;
- (d) “senior official ” in relation to a department is a reference to an officer of or above Grade 3 or, as the case may require, Diplomatic Service Senior Grade;
- (e) “wireless telegraphy ” has the same meaning as in the ^{M3}Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949 and, in relation to wireless telegraphy, “interfere ” has the same meaning as in that Act;
- (f) “working day ” means any day other than a Saturday, a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a day which is a bank holiday under the ^{M4}Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971 in any part of the United Kingdom.

- (2) In consequence of the preceding provisions of this Act, the 1989 Act, the ^{M5}Official Secrets Act 1989 and the ^{M6}Official Secrets Act 1989 (Prescription) Order 1990 shall have effect subject to the amendments in Schedule 4 to this Act.
