11 Interpretation and consequential amendments. U.K.

(1) In this Act—

- (a) “the 1989 Act ” means the ^{M1}Security Service Act 1989;

- ^{F3}(d) “senior official ” has the same meaning as in the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000;]
- (e) “wireless telegraphy ” has the same meaning as in [^{F4}the Wireless Telegraphy Act 2006] and, in relation to wireless telegraphy, “interfere ” has the same meaning as in that Act;
- (f) “working day ” means any day other than a Saturday, a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a day which is a bank holiday under the ^{M2}Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971 in any part of the United Kingdom.

^{F5}(1A) Section 81(5) of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000 (meaning of “prevention ” and “detection ”), so far as it relates to serious crime, shall [^{F6}apply for the purposes of this Act as it applies for the purposes of that Act, except that for the purposes of section 3 above it shall not include a reference to gathering evidence for use in any legal proceedings (within the meaning of that Act).]]

(2) In consequence of the preceding provisions of this Act, the 1989 Act, the ^{M3}Official Secrets Act 1989 and the ^{M4}Official Secrets Act 1989 (Prescription) Order 1990 shall have effect subject to the amendments in Schedule 4 to this Act.
