APPLICATION OF CRIMINAL LAW TO UNITED KINGDOM NATIONALS

21 United Kingdom nationals in the unclaimed sector of Antarctica.

Where a United Kingdom national does or omits to do anything on any land lying south of 60° South latitude and between 150° West longitude and 90° West longitude and that act or omission would have constituted an offence under the law of any part of the United Kingdom if it had occurred in that part, he shall be guilty of the like offence as if the act or omission had taken place in that part, and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly.

Changes to legislation:
