APPLICATION OF CRIMINAL LAW TO UNITED KINGDOM NATIONALS

24 Proceedings for offences under Part III.

Where by virtue of section 21, 22 or 23 a person is liable to be proceeded against for an offence in any part of the United Kingdom, the proceedings may be taken, and the offence may for incidental purposes be treated as having been committed, in any place in that part.
